

Comes now, Detective Sergeant Kris Seymore , and after first being duly sworn upon his oath, deposes and says that he is a law enforcement officer of Elkhart County, Indiana, and the above named individual was arrested because:

On September 26, 2016 at approximately 1256hrs, the Allen County IN Sheriff's Department issued an Amber Alert for Liliana Hernandez, 7yrs old, and Rene Pasztor, 6 yrs old. The children were believed to have been forcibly abducted by their non custodial mother, Amber Pasztor. The vehicle description given in the Amber Alert was a Tan Mercury Mystique.

At approximately 1725hrs, Corporal Norm Friend of the Elkhart Police Department, was flagged down in the 100 blk of East Marion St., directly behind the Elkhart Police Department. The person flagging Corporal Friend down was identified as Amber Pasztor, who was driving a Tan Mercury Mystique. Pasztor told Corporal Friend that her children were dead and located in the back seat of the vehicle in question. Corporal Friend confirmed that the children were in the back seat and called for additional officers to his location. Lieutenant Doug Ryback confirmed that both children were dead and asked Amber Pasztor what had happened. Amber replied that she had "smothered them". Pasztor was detained based off of these utterances and was also found to have an unrelated warrant for her arrest out of Fort Wayne IN.

Amber Pasztor was interviewed by Detective Jeff Eaton, where Amber detailed kicking in the door of her father's home and taking both children out of the home in Fort Wayne earlier in the day. Amber then traveled to Elkhart with both children, making several stops including a restaurant and park, and at some point covered both of their faces and nose with her hands until they both died. Amber motioned with her hands over her face to show Detective Eaton how she did this.

On September 27, 2016, an autopsy was performed on Liliana Hernandez and Rene Pasztor by Dr Douglas and Dr. Dejong. The autopsy was performed at the Homer Strycker School of Medicine, Western Michigan University MI. Preliminary findings concluded that Hernandez and Pasztor's cause of death was due to asphyxiation and the manner of death was ruled a homicide for both children.

I, Detective Sergeant Kris Seymore, affirm under the pain and penalty of perjury that the above foregoing facts are true and correct, are within the Personal knowledge of the undersigned, and occurred within Elkhart County, Indiana.
