AFFIDAVIT FOR PROBABLE CAUSE

Comes now Christopher Jones, who hereby swears upon his oath, deposes and says:

- 1. I am a Law Enforcement Officer with the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office.
- 2. I am filing this affidavit for probable cause in support of the charges of Possession of Marijuana, against Mamdou L Ndiaye, a black/male, DOB: 03/16/1976, height 6'0", weight 170 lbs, with black hair and black eyes.

3. On 07/12/2017, I came into contact with the accused in the following manner: I randomly ran Indiana temp plate 7583054, which showed the registered owner had a suspended-infraction driver's license. I pulled beside the vehicle and saw the driver matched the description of the registered owner so I initiated a traffic stop.

4. During the course of my contact, I found the following substance: Pure CBD Tincture 100mg 1oz/30ml glass dropper bottle containing a yellowish liquid.

a: in the glove box of a white 1998 Mercury Grand Marquis in which the accused was present, and was the driver./owner.

5. I have had the following training and/or experience in the identification of Marijuana: ILEA and have made numerous arrest for possession of marijuana and based on this, I was able to identify the substance seized as such.

6. My own identification was confirmed by:

a: a field test conducted by Christopher Jones, of the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office.

b: examination by _____ of the _____ who is trained in the identification of drugs.

All of the above events occurred in Hamilton County, Indiana.
